### **DoD Kidney Cancer Research Program Funding opportunity!**

#### Department of Defence KCRP Grant Program - Up to \$15 Million in Funding

The FY18 Defense Appropriation provides \$15 million (M) to the Department of Defense Kidney Cancer Research Program (KCRP) to support research of exceptional scientific merit in the area of kidney cancer.

There are 5 categories:

- a) **Concept Award** \$75,000 over 1 year, to s upport highly innovative, untested, potentially groundbreaking concepts in kidney cancer
- b) **Idea Development Award** \$400,000 over 2 years, to s upport new ideas that represent innovative, high-risk/high-gain approaches to kidney cancer research, and have the potential to make an important contribution to kidney cancer
- c) **Physician Research Award** \$200,000 over 2 year, to support a mentored research experience to prepare physicians with clinical duties and/or responsibilities for productive careers in kidney cancer research
- d) **Technology Development award** \$300,000 over 3 years, to support emerging technologies to aid clinical and patient outcomes. Preliminary data are required
- e) **Translational Research Partnership Award** \$600,000 over 3 years, to support a partnership between a clinician and a laboratory scientist for translational correlative studies.

The LOI for the Concept Award is due July 11, 2018 with full application on August 8,2018

LOIs for all other awards due **Sep 5, 2018** with full applications due Sep 26, 2018.
